Sight Word Practice Activities

1. Matching



Students write sight words on a white board. Students also write the same sight words on sticky notes. (It's great practice to have the STUDENT read each word and write it on both the sticky note and the white board!) Then the student reads each word and matches the sticky note to the white board.

2. Sensory activities

Write sight words in play doh.



3. Build sight words using letter magnets on a cookie sheet.



4. Rainbow write sight words using a whiteboard and dry erase markers.



5. Sight Word Twister outside with chalk words. (Again, have the STUDENT help write the words.)



6. Sight Word Tic Tac Toe using a blank tic tac toe board and sticky notes (or pennies).
