$$1 + 0 = 1$$

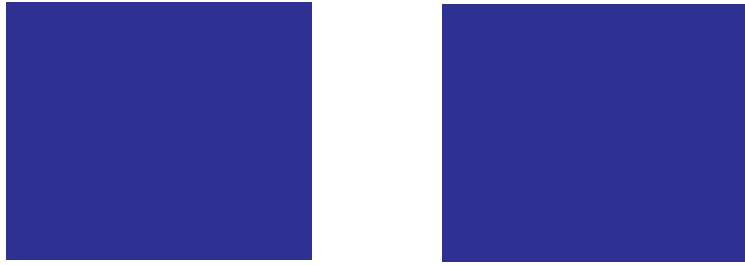
When you add 0 to a number the sum is that same number.

4 and below let it go!



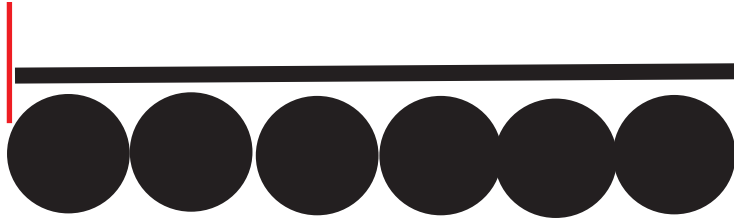
52 rounded to the nearest 10 is 50

To double is to add the number to itself.

doubles plus one

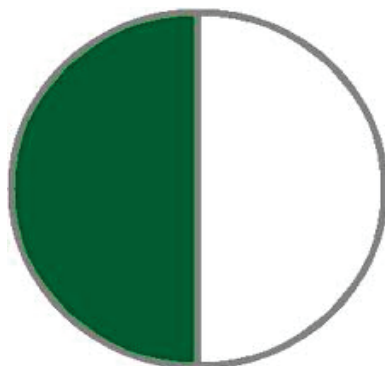

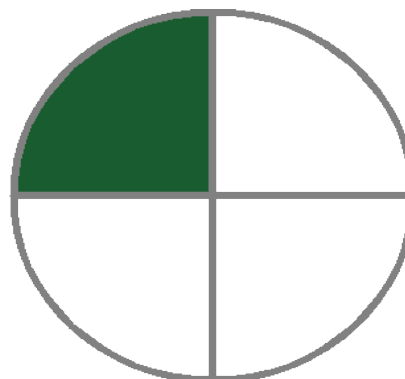
